for your Print-Ready Gift Certificate

This Gift Certificate is protected under U.S. and International Copyright laws. We don't like a lot of legal jargon, and know you don't either, so in plain English here's the bottom line:

This Gift Certificate is for your use only, and not for resale.

Where can you use it? You may use this Gift Certificate to support your practice. If you work in multiple places, it's fine to use the Certificate wherever you practice.

Can you let others use the certificate? Yes, if they work for you in a business you own, up to a limit of 10 business locations.

How many copies may you print? You may print as many copies as you like, as long as you use them in compliance with this License.

Can you use the gift certificate art in other ways? You can use the art in whole, as you downloaded it in other ways. For example, as an eCertificate which you email to clients. You could also use the image on your website, client newsletter, or advertisements to market your gift certificate sales. You are not allowed to extract portions of the gift certificate art to use in any context.

Why can't you extract and use portions of the art? We license our graphics from other companies, and are prohibited from reselling them separate from the product that uses them. This means you do not have authorization to take part of the image and use it in another context. For example, if the art you download includes a photo of a person receiving a massage, you are not allowed to crop out other images, background, or text that accompany it and use that massage photo by itself, in any context.

On the plus side, you get a Gift Certificate with beautiful images that would be very expensive to acquire on your own. The downside is that these companies depend on protected use of their images, and they do pursue unlicensed users.
